



## HOUSE OF BREAD

*Come to Bethlehem and see  
him whose birth the angels sing!*

*Bethlehem means House of Bread in Hebrew. The shepherds traveled to Bethlehem to see the Christ Child. We see and touch and taste his presence today as we eat the bread of the Lord's Supper.*

Here is a recipe for communion bread.

6 cups wheat flour	1C 1 tablespoon cinnamon
1 cup brown sugar	<del>4</del> 4 teaspoons honey
1 tablespoon salt	1/2 cup shortening
<del>2</del> 2 teaspoons baking soda	<del>2</del> 2 cups water
2 teaspoons baking powder	

Mix flour, sugar, salt, baking soda, baking powder, and cinnamon together. Add honey, shortening, and water one at a time, mixing after each addition. Knead dough on a floured board about 10 minutes. Divide the dough into 4 or 5 balls. Roll out each ball to 1/8 inch thickness. Bake on an ungreased cookie sheet at 350 degrees for 10 minutes.
